Trunk includes:

- Large color poster *Carolina Shout* with discussion questions and additional prints for use in classroom during loan period.
- Books, Audio visuals, Jazz CD.

- Biographical information about Romare Bearden. Scripted questions and answers designed to engage students and to encourage exploration of collage art techniques and primary Bearden themes.
- Lesson plans that reinforces 4th and 5th grade math, science, social studies, and/or language arts and establishes a connection to the visual arts.

EXAMPLES

- Write and illustrate your own “Memory Book” about Romare Bearden.
- Make a felt and paper collage based on *Evening of the Gray Cat* (interactive activity)
- Experiment with warm and cool colors in a science lesson. (*Carolina Shout* Art Link poster included)
- Assessments to evaluate students’ comprehension of the lesson.
